No specific subjective criteria and award fee was set aside in the approved PEMP for this period. However, the determination of the overall fee earned did consider the aggregate effect of both the Achievements and Areas for Improvement noted during the period.

Achievements:

- Successful completion of an extended Liquid Waste System wide outage in preparation for full system production during Extension Period 3.
- Successful completion of 2H and 3H evaporator re-start pre-requisites in preparation for full operations in Extension Period 3.
- Continued progress on installation of the Tank Closure Cesium Removal (TCCR) process equipment and infrastructure necessary to support full operations in Extension Period 3.
- Continued progress on modifying canister storage positions in Glass Waste Storage Building (GWSB) #1 to allow double-stacking of DWPF canisters.
- Continued progress on the design and construction of Saltstone Disposal Units (SDUs) 7, 8 and 9.
- The contractor continues to maintain high standards and performance in contract management activities as exemplified by the expeditious development and submittal of their contract proposal for the third contract extension.
- The contractor successfully completed essentially all the objective requirements of the available performance fee.
