Notice of Floodplain and Wetland Action at the Savannah River Site

The Department of Energy (DOE) requires periodic herbicide application to DOE-owned 115-kV electricity transmission line rights-of-way on the Savannah River Site. This Floodplain and Wetlands Assessment was prepared in compliance with 10 CFR 1022 as documentation of potential impacts of the action. Herbicide application locations subject to the assessment are associated within the watersheds of Four Mile Branch, Indian Grave Branch, Meyers Branch, Pen Branch, Steel Creek, Tims Branch, and Upper Three Runs within Aiken County, South Carolina, and Barnwell County, South Carolina. A fifteen (15) day public comment period on the action will be from April 3, 2020 to April 18, 2020.
